CLOTHING AND TEXTILES PROJECT

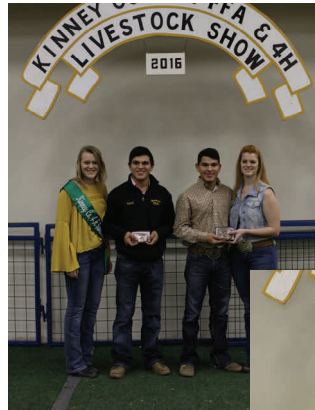

VALIDATION PERIOD IS:
March 1, 2016 to April 15, 2016
\$10.00 per horse
April 16, 2016 to May 1, 2016
\$20.00 per horse

VALIDATION is done on 4-H Connect
You will need a digital picture of all sides of your horse that can be uploaded to your page. You will need a Coggins test that will be current through the State Horse Show. Registered horses need a .pdf copy of registration papers.

Major Stock Show Steer tags must be ordered by April 15th at \$12 a tag.

Juniors - 3rd and 8 years old to 5th grade

Intermediates—6th to 8th grade

Seniors—9th to 12th grade and 18 after Aug. 31

D-10 FASHION SHOW
